Our Ebglyss[®] study includes

- 1-3 phone interviews during your pregnancy and at least 1 interview after you have your baby.
- Your permission to obtain a copy of your and your baby's medical records from your healthcare providers.
- An opportunity to receive a specialized, non-invasive exam of your baby with a study doctor.
- A neurodevelopment assessment that can also provide insight into the child's development at approximately 12 months of age.

If you have eczema (atopic dermatitis) and have taken Ebglyss® at any point from 123 days before conception through your current pregnancy, you may qualify for this important study.
