

Seeking Information

- •Questions and concerns from moms, providers, others
- •Origins of Teratogen Information Centers (after Teratology Society)
- •Trips to the library
- Reading the research
- •Online libraries/publications



Learning the Processes

- Training
- •Listening to colleagues, students
- •Answering calls
- •Monthly seminars, Shepard's Criteria
- Teaching students
- •OTIS meetings and presentations
- Listserv questions



Applying the Processes

- •Finding and comparing summaries
- •Reading original research and meta-analyses
- Relying upon the literature and process
- •Going through Shepard's Criteria
- •Forming answer for risks
- •Discussing answer and findings with colleagues



Responding to Inquiries

- •Questions/probing for context
- Providing information for the situation
- Not providing medical advice
- Protecting privacy, demographics
- •Study referrals, follow-up
- •Filling a void that providers are not doing (system issues)



Representing Organizations

- •National organizations, OTIS, TS/BDRP
 - Committee membership, committee leadership
 - Benefits for organization
 - Professional development for members
 - Supportive environment of co-chairs and members
- State and local committees
 - FASD, migrant health, diabetes, air quality, etc.



Becoming the "Expert"

- •Blogs, podcasts, newsletters
- News interviews
- •Fact Sheets
- •Journal articles (teratogen update on antithyroid meds, MMI)
- •Combinations (calls, fact sheets, articles)



Continuing the Cycle

- Ongoing professional development
- Seeking new information
- •Honing skills
- •Promoting research, studies, PRGLAC, etc.
 - Dealing with the results of the lack of research, COVID-19 vaccine



Supportive Environment

- Multidisciplinary society/expertise
 - Professionals, disciplines
- •Team approach
 - Collaboration, ok to not know the answer
- •Different styles
