





LactRx App

LactRx by MotherToBaby is a free app providing current information on the use of medications, vaccines, diagnostic agents and drugs of misuse during breastfeeding. The app has been downloaded over 6,700 times with 13,238 engaged sessions.



Pregnancy Studies

MotherToBaby conducts observational research that allows experts to determine if medications/vaccines pose a risk to pregnancy or a developing baby.




